

Group touring has many well-known benefits. With all the logistics taken care of, you're able to sit back and enjoy every moment of your holiday. See more for your money and make great friends along the way.

However, there is one downside to traditional coach touring that nobody talks about - the practicality of travelling in a large group.

There's lots of waiting for everybody to catch up or just to get on or off the bus, the extra time taken to allocate hotel rooms, check-in or order at a restaurant. Then there's being told where to sit, the issue of missing out on views while on safari and not getting the


Guaranteed Departure

We've also covered the permits for gorilla and golden monkey tracking. To give you an idea, a gorilla-tracking permit costs approximately \$1,500pp US and a golden monkey permit around \$100pp US.


On the water

AFRICA EXPERIENCES

Cultural spotlight

Africa is famous for its incredible wildlife, but there's also vibrant culture to be found in almost every region we visit. From the Timkat Festival in Ethiopia, the Himba people in Namibia, the local people in Samburu and the Nanyuki Spinners and Weavers in Kenya, there's so much to discover!

Along with animals, our itineraries put an emphasis on experiencing cultures, interacting with the locals and visiting rural villages because we believe this helps to benefit the communities and really capture the essence of the places we visit.











Bunnik Tours firmly believes that tourism can create understanding between cultures and generate economic and social benefits in the places we visit. Our small groups are low-impact and don't ruin the very places we go to see.

In Africa we only use professionally accredited guides and expert trackers trained in animal behaviour and protection. Guides undergo rigorous training in ethics and procedures to ensure minimal impact on the environment and the wildlife. They are also required to report any unusual activities.

We only visit national parks and private concessions where animals roam freely in their natural habitat, and we strictly adhere to rules designed to protect the natural environment and prevent human/wildlife conflict.





A day on safari!

Safari is the quintessential African experience. Whether you're spotting lions in the Maasai Mara, watching elephants drink at a waterhole in Chobe National Park, or tracking wildebeest in the Ngorongoro Crater - every day is a new adventure.



An early start!

We wake up with the sun to beat the heat of the day and witness the wildlife and landscapes bathed in the beautiful morning glow.

Dressed in light, layered clothing and sturdy shoes, and after a quick coffee or tea, we board our safari vehicle. The mornings can still be quite cold so we suggest you also bring a scarf and beanie.

Our safari vehicles are normally 7 or 9 person 4WDs so everyone gets close to the action. For touring in East Africa, our 4WDs travel with only 6 people in each - meaning everyone gets a window seat. In some of the national parks our vehicles are open-top, and in others we're enclosed for protection.

Have your camera and binoculars ready. Our drivers and guides are experts and will find the best spots to see a myriad of local wildlife over the next few hours.

Relax & recharge

After an exciting morning we'll return to the lodge for breakfast. Then it's time to relax, lounge by the pool with a book or explore the grounds.

There's some more time at leisure after lunch (you might want to catch up on sleep after our early-morning start).

Evening excitement

As the sun begins to set, we prepare for our second game drive of the day. We head off on another incredible game drive, this time to capture magnificent wildlife and scenery in the golden hour.

It wouldn't be a trip to Africa without sundowners overlooking the vast savannahs. We'll then return to our lodge and prepare for dinner and an evening under the stars.

April to June

- Experience the 'smoke that thunders' during high-water season at Victoria Falls
- Botswana's Okavango Delta is in full flood and offers incredible views, especially on scenic flights
- Enjoy green scenery, young wildlife and fewer crowds in the reserves of Kenya and Tanzania
- The waterholes in Namibia's Etosha National Park come alive with wildlife and the dry salt pans make for spectacular photos




July to September

Passport & visas

Your documents, including itineraries and hotel lists, are prepared approximately three weeks before you depart.



Tipping Made Easy

Tipping is not a part of everyday Australian life, so many of us feel unsure about when or how much to tip. However, tipping is expected in many of the countries we visit and often makes up a large part of people's wages, so it's important to get it right.

For this reason we have developed a program for selected destinations. This simple system sees us collect tips at the time of booking. We then pass these tips to our local staff and they take care of all the tipping. Easy! It is compulsory for logistical reasons that all tour members participate.





Let's talk fitness

At Bunnik Tours we don't put specific age limits on our tours, but we also recognise some travellers may find our itineraries challenging.

We have a duty of care to all tour participants and the tour guides, so we do impose a firm policy on the level of fitness required by all our clients to prioritise your safety and the safety of other travellers on our tours.

At Bunnik Tours our goal is for all our travellers to enjoy their tour, not struggle through it! This is why we want to work with you to ensure you are on the best possible tour for your fitness level. We do reserve the right to refuse bookings if we feel that the requirements of the tour are too demanding.

Bunnik Tours are for independently-minded travellers with good levels of mobility.

Travellers to Africa can expect:

- Long days of travelling, at times on dirt and gravel roads
- 2. Extended periods at high altitude (3,000-4,000 metres in Ethiopia)
- 3. Extended periods of walking or hiking through humid forests
- 4. Limited medical facilities in remote areas

Bunnik Tours travellers need to:

- 1. Be able to walk for a minimum of 2-3 hours on uneven surfaces, on any given day
- 2. Walk up multiple flights of stairs and short, steep hills
- 3. Stand for a minimum of 20 minutes without needing to sit down, often in hot/humid climates
- 4. Carry their own luggage
- 5. Get on and off various modes of transport without assistance, including small boats

Please note: Passengers who are 75 and over will be required to obtain a doctor's clearance before travelling.



Luggage restrictions

Given the limited storage space in light aircraft and safari vehicles, for travel within Africa a soft bag is required.

For the following tours, there is also a maximum weight of 15kg per person: South Africa, Botswana & Kenya; South Africa & Zimbabwe; Kenya & Tanzania; Kenya & Ethiopia; Cairo to Zanzibar; and Morocco & Kenya

- Stand for a minimum of 20 minutes without needing to sit down, often in hot/humid climates
- 4. Carry your own luggage
- 5. Get on and off various modes of transport without assistance, including small boats

Passengers 75 years or over must provide a signed Fitness to Travel declaration form (Part 2) from their doctor within one month of making their booking.

While we will still confirm your place on your tour, flight tickets cannot be issued until both completed forms have been received. Additional costs may be incurred if completed forms are not received by Bunnik Tours within these time frames.

Bunnik Tours generally does not accept bookings for single travellers 80 years of age and over without a travelling companion. Neither our Tour Director nor your fellow travellers are equipped to act as a carer.

Passengers must inform us and the service provider of any medical conditions which may affect your ability to participate in the tour.

At our discretion we, including the service provider, can exclude you in a tour or in any activity if we consider that you are unable to safely participate in that tour or activity or if we consider your participation may place the safety of other quests at risk.

We exclude all liability for any illness, injury or death sustained by you on tour because of any pre-existing medical condition. You release us from all liability arising out of your medical condition, illness, or injury that you may suffer during the tour or as a result of the tour.

TRAVEL INSURANCE

While travel insurance is not inclusive in the tour fee, it is mandatory for all our clients travelling on a Bunnik Tour to obtain comprehensive travel insurance to cover you throughout the whole duration of the tour to cover costs associated with illness, injury, death, loss of or damage to baggage and personal items, cancellations, loss of deposit, medical and hospitalization expenses, repatriation and curtailments expenses due to illness, the need to return home unexpectedly, evacuation expenses, and accidental death or disability. This should be taken out at time of booking.

It is your responsibility to obtain comprehensive travel insurance, however please note that travel insurance offered by credit card companies may not be considered adequate cover.

AMENDMENT FEES

A fee of \$250 or more per person, per change plus any further cost we incur will be charged for any revision or alteration made to a reservation after the booking is confirmed unless the change increases the price of the booking. Costs and charges may increase the closer to the departure date that changes are made, so you should contact us as soon as possible. Amendments will be made at our discretion and may not always be possible.

OTHER CONDITIONS

Bunnik Tours reserves the right to cancel or withdraw bookings made for or on behalf of a client at any time at their discretion, in which event no liability with respect to the cancellation or withdrawal shall fall on Bunnik Tours, save that all the monies paid for the booking shall be

refunded, less any utilised land or transport content. The arrangement of this holiday constitutes a complete package and as such, an itemisation of costs will not be rendered. No refunds are payable on unused or partially utilised sections of the tour itinerary, where passengers amend, cancel, or otherwise vary arrangements after tour departure.

Bunnik Tours does not authorise any overseas suppliers including hotel management to promise refunds on our behalf.

TRAVEL DOCUMENTS AND TAXES

We cannot be held responsible for any subsequent complaint with arrangements booked directly with suppliers abroad.

Cancellations of confirmed services must be notified through Bunnik Tours even if you have advised the local representative. Bunnik Tours does not authorise the employees of any overseas supplier to promise refunds to clients.

We may vary these Booking Conditions from time to time by notifying you in writing.

CANCELLATION
