

"Only in Namibia could a prehistoric plant be the stuff of giants. The Welwitschia Mirabilis is the national flower of Namibia and it's survived millennia in the Namib Desert to evolve into a rather curious looking plant. When we spot these gems in the desert, we'll tell you how you can determine whether it's male or female and share how old it is based on its size. A special hint is that they only grow a few inches a year, so the giant ones in the desert are estimated to be 1,500 to 2,000 years old."



ONE TREE PLANTED

In 2018, we offered our guests the opportunity to choose paper free documentation, resulting in over 70% of our guests opting for this environmentally friendly option. And to thank every guest who chooses e-documentations, we plant a tree in their honour. Together with our partner One Tree Planted, we have already reforested 150 acres of devastated land in places such as Tanzania.
